

CCDF Response to Questions received regarding the 2023 CCDF Summer Program

I have a question regarding application #4(b) states: Summer program activities must be offered at least 10 weeks, five days a week, 4 hours per day.

“Our organization plans to conduct two programs in two different schools, each running for five weeks. However, the two programs will run simultaneously. My question is: will this be considered 10 weeks?”

CCDF Response: Running two (2) programs in two (2) different schools simultaneously each running for five weeks will not be considered 10 weeks.

If the program is run from one school for 5 weeks, then followed in the next school for another 5 weeks will be considered 10 weeks. As an example: Summer Program is run at School A from May 22 to June 23 then Summer Program is continued at School B from June 26 to July 28 will be considered 10 weeks.
