Child Care Providers Attend the Health and Safety Training on Prevention on Shaken Baby Syndrome and Abusive Head Trauma

On November 8, 2023, twenty (20) ongoing child care providers attended a two- hour health and safety training on "*Prevention of Shaken Baby Syndrome and Abusive Head Trauma*". This remote training was conducted by Evergreen Learning Technical Assistance Specialist, Russelle Mae Ignacio.

The new federal requirements of the Child Care Development Block Grant Act of 2014 (CCDBG) require all providers receiving Child Care Development funds to implement health and safety provisions that address the prevention of shaken baby syndrome and abusive head trauma in a child care setting.
