





## Child Care Providers Attend the Health and Safety Training on Prevention on Sudden Infant Death Syndrome (SIDS) and The Use of Safe Sleep Practices

On Monday, November 6, 2023, Russelle Mae Ignacio, Evergreen Learning Technical Assistance Specialist facilitated a two- hour health and safety training to nineteen (19) ongoing child care providers from Saipan on '*Prevention on Sudden Infant Death Syndrome (SIDS) and The Use of Safe Sleep Practices*".

The goal of this training is to help providers understand what is sudden unexpected infant death (SUID) and sudden infant death syndrome (SIDS), be knowledgeable of the risk factors that underlie SIDS, be aware of providers role in reducing risk for SIDS and know how to identify safe sleep practices aimed at reducing the risk for both SUIDs and SIDS in the child care setting.
