## **Child Care Providers Attend the Health and Safety Training on Administration of Medication, Consistent with Standards for Parental Consent**

A two-hour health and safety training on the “*Administration of Medication, Consistent with Standards for Parental Consent*” was facilitated by Evergreen Learning Technical Assistance Specialist Russelle Mae Ignacio. This training was conducted via remote learning on November 27, 2023. In attendance was a total of four (4) new teachers and sixteen (16) ongoing providers from different childcare centers in Saipan.

The standards and best practices mentioned in this training were taken from the CNMI Child Care Licensing (CCLP) regulations and Caring for our Children (CFOC).
