Child Care Providers Attend the Health and Safety Training on Child Development

On December 9, 2023, Evergreen Learning Technical Assistance Specialist, Russelle Mae Ignacio, conducted a two-hour health and safety training on “*Child Development*” for fifteen (15) childcare providers in Saipan and Tinian via remote learning.

This training provided participants an overview of child development that included understanding developmental milestones to help adults become aware of children’s skills at certain ages. The training also helped them plan age-appropriate activities for the children under their care. In addition, they identified warning signs and possible delays in children’s development.

This training was made possible through funding from the Department of Health and Human Services, Office of Child Care, CNMI CCDF Program under the Department of Community and Cultural Affairs.
