Child Care Providers Attend the Health and Safety Training on Prevention and Control of Infectious Diseases Including Immunization

A two-hour health and safety training on the *"Prevention and Control of Infectious Diseases Including Immunization"* was facilitated by Evergreen Learning Technical Assistance Specialist Russelle Mae Ignacio. This training was conducted via remote learning on December 2, 2023. In attendance were a total of fourteen (14) ongoing providers from childcare centers in Saipan.

Participants in this training explored topics such as the spread of infectious diseases, handwashing policies and procedures for children and staff, the difference between cleaning, sanitizing and disinfecting, why conducting a daily health check is important, and immunizations for staff and children.
