Child Care Providers Attend the Health and Safety Training on Precautions in Transporting Children

On Wednesday, November 29, 2023, a training on “*Precautions in Transporting Children*” was conducted for four (4) new teachers and sixteen (16) child care providers from Saipan via remote learning. This two-hour health and safety training was facilitated by Russelle Mae Ignacio, Evergreen Learning Technical Assistance Specialist.

The aim of this training is to provide information on the application of health and safety standards in relation to appropriate precautions to take when transporting children, to increase knowledge of how to identify hazards in and around vehicles, and to teach ways to protect children from risk and injury from those hazards.
