## **Health and Safety Training on Child Development**

On June 04, 2024, six (6) participants from ZFFC Before and Afterschool Program, and Team Koka–Tinian completed a two-hour training on *Child Development*. This remote training was facilitated by Evergreen Learning Training and Development Specialist, Grace M. Mallari.

During the training session, participants identified the four developmental domains: social-emotional, language, cognitive, and physical movement. They also learned the importance of recognizing and fostering these domains in a childcare setting through interaction, engagement, and planned activities.
